The concert is part of Nick Biebricher's Sandy Roots Songwriters Series, a yearlong original music series to be held the third Tuesday of each month. The shows last approximately three hours. There will be a \$5 cover.

An open mic night for local original songwriters will follow each showcase. Biebricher said the series will give local singer/songwriters the opportunity to showcase their talents with the best singer/songwriters from around the country.
